### *Introductory paragraph*

Hook (to catch reader's interest)  
Thesis statement  
Overview of reasons  
Mostly (if not all) your opinion

### *Body Paragraph (Reason #1)*

State your 1<sup>st</sup> reason  
Defend your reason by explaining why your opinion is valid  
Must include 1 quote from your research (cited correctly)

### *Body Paragraph (Reason #2)*

State your 2<sup>nd</sup> reason  
Defend your reason by explaining why your opinion is valid  
Must include 1 quote from your research (cited correctly)

### *Body Paragraph (Reason #3)*

State your 3<sup>rd</sup> reason  
Defend your reason by explaining why your opinion is valid  
Must include 1 quote from your research (cited correctly)

### *Conclusion*

Restate your thesis  
Summarize your argument  
Mostly (if not all) your opinion  
Closing statement
